**INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATE APPEARING IN THE NCERT LDC WRITTEN
EXAMINATION ON 04/12/2016 (SUNDAY)**

1. The examination will be held on 04/12/2016 (Sunday) in two shifts from 10.00 AM to 01.00 PM & 02.00 PM to 05.00 PM.
2. Candidate who appear in one shift will not be allowed to appear in other shift.
3. For candidates appearing in the morning shift, no entry after 09:55 AM. Candidates cannot leave before 01:00 PM .
4. For candidates appearing in the evening shift, no entry after 01:55 PM. Candidates cannot leave before 05:00 PM .
5. After issue of Admit Card check the particulars in the Admit Card carefully. Error, if any, must be immediately reported to NCERT e - mail - ncetr2@gmail.com .
6. Once inside the Examination Centre premises, all candidates will be under surveillance, hence advised not to indulge into any unlawful activity which will be monitored & will invite disqualification and legal action.
7. Entry to Examination Hall is subject to production of Admit Card and Photo I.D. proof (issued only by the Govt.) to prove identity.
8. Wrist Watches having mobile or computing capacity, Cell phones, pagers, calculators or any electronic devices are strictly prohibited. Violation may lead to expulsion from the examination. No arrangements have been made at the centres for their custody. Only ordinary wrist watch will be allowed.
9. Do not carry any article, except Admit Card, Photograph and Photo I.D. Proof, Black /Blue Ball Pen in the examination hall.
10. Change or cancellation of answer once marked, is NOT permissible.
11. Handover the Admit Card to the Invigilator after completion of exam.
